The Moms Club of North Dallas helped us have a great Easter egg hunt.

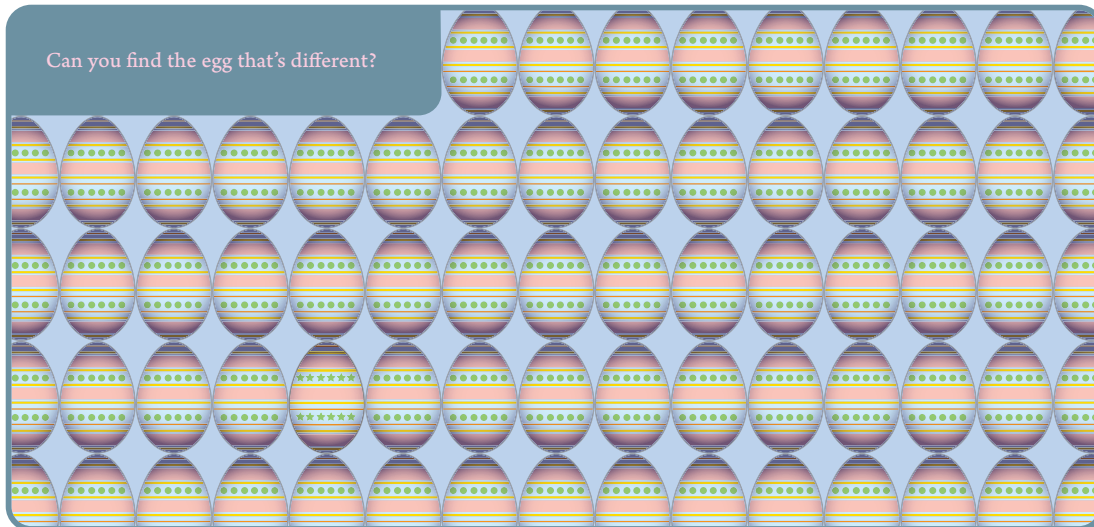


We had Easter eggs filled with all sorts of treats so everyone could enjoy being young for a day or so.

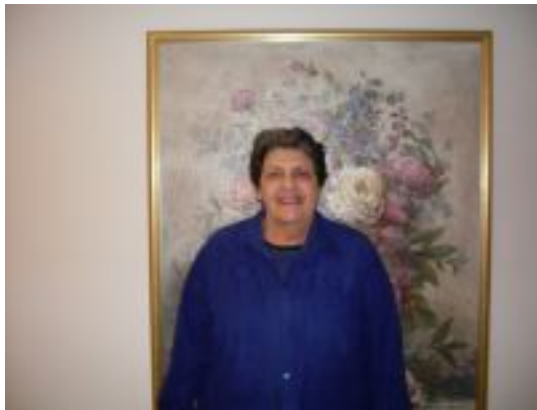

Celebrate Juneteenth

Although President Lincoln's Emancipation Proclamation took effect on Jan. 1, 1863, many slaves, especially in Texas, were not actually free until two-and-a-half years later. "Juneteenth" celebrates the actual ending of slavery when, on June 19, 1865, 2,000 federal troops landed in Galveston, Tex., with news that the war was over and slaves were now free. Why the delay?

Several theories exist:

- Some say the messenger assigned to bring word to Texas was killed en route.
- Others believe the news was withheld on purpose by enslavers who needed to maintain a labor force.
- Still others think the federal troops waited for one last cotton harvest.

Despite the questions, one thing is certain: Many rejoiced in jubilation. Today, the event celebrates African-American freedom and encourages respect and self-development for all cultures.

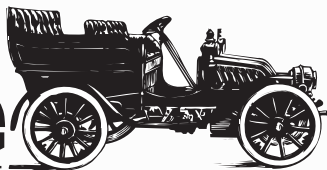
